Tim Moore and Jerry Boykin will serve as the co-hosts of this pilgrimage. Tim is a retired Air Force Colonel and former State Representative. He is the Senior Evangelist and Director for Lamb & Lion Ministries. Lt. General Boykin served with the elite Delta Force and was the commanding general of the 1st Special Forces Command. He was later appointed Deputy Under Secretary of Defense for Intelligence. Today, he is the executive vice president of the Family Research Council in Washington, DC. Together, they represent many years of military experience and Christian passion for the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

Dates: June 22 – July 3, 2024

Agent: Discovery Cruises and Tours (DC&T) in Hurst, Texas (817-595-2700)

Co-Hosts: Tim Moore and Jerry Boykin

Air: Round trip — Newark (EWR) to Israel via El Al Airlines. The flight from EWR is on the evening of June 22nd non-stop to Tel Aviv. If you want to secure your own air transportation or use your accumulated air miles, you can meet us in Tel Aviv and just pay “Ground Only” cost of the trip. Our tour broker can supply you with that information.

Hotels: 2 nights in Tel Aviv at the Herods Hotel

3 nights in Tiberias at the Leonardo Plaza Hotel

5 nights in Jerusalem at the Dan Panorama Hotel

Meals: Three meals daily in Israel consisting of buffet breakfast, lunch, and full dinner.

Bus: Deluxe air-conditioned motorcoach with an English-speaking Israeli guide.



Itinerary (Planned)

Day 1 Sat, June 22	Depart Newark for Tel Aviv. Flight # 26 departs at 11:50 PM and flies non-stop to Tel Aviv. Meals served in flight.
Day 2 Sun, June 23	Arrive in Tel Aviv in the late afternoon. Overnight in Tel Aviv.
Day 3 Mon, June 24	Old Jaffa & Tel Aviv — Etzel Museum / Independence Hall / Joppa / Palmach Museum / Rabin Assassination Site. Overnight in Tel Aviv.
Day 4 Tue, June 25	Tel Aviv to Tiberias — Via Mares / Ebenezer / Mt. Carmel / Tel Megiddo / Gideon Spring / Mt Gilboa. Overnight in Tiberias.
Day 5 Wed, June 26	Golan Heights — Tel Hazor / Tel Faher / Mount Bental / Caesarea Philippi / Kursi / Gamla / Nimrod Fortress. Overnight in Tiberias.
Day 6 Thur, June 27	Northern Israel — Lebanese Border / Mt Adir / Acco / Haifa / Kibbutz Degania / Yardenit. Overnight in Tiberias.
Day 7 Fri, June 28	Central Israel to Jerusalem — Mount Tabor / Bet Shean / Jericho / Arrive Jerusalem. Overnight in Jerusalem.
Day 8 Sat, June 29	Old City of Jerusalem — Tomb of Samuel / Radar Hill, Samuel Overlook / Ammunition Hill / Lion's Gate / Paratroopers' Walk to Western Wall / Pool of Bethesda / Church of Holy Sepulcher / Antonio Fortress / Mount Herzl. Overnight in Jerusalem.
Day 9 Sun, June 30	North and West of Jerusalem — Elah Valley / Tel Lachish / Latrun / IDF Armor Corps Museum / Mount of Olives / Dominus Flevit. Overnight in Jerusalem
Day 10 Mon, July 1	South of Jerusalem and the Negev — Gush Etzion / Beer Sheba / IAF Museum. Overnight in Jerusalem.
Day 11 Tue, July 2	Jerusalem — Friends of Zion Museum / Garden of Gethsemane / Garden Tomb. Transfer to Airport late at night.
Day 12 Wed, July 3	Departure & Arrival in the States. Meals Served in Flight.

Cost: Basic cost is **\$5,429** per person. This price includes all transportation, lodging, meals, taxes, and a fuel surcharge. It does not include tips. There is always a possibility that the airline may increase the fuel surcharge which currently is \$760. **(Ground Only price is \$3,844.)**

Tips: Tips are \$192 per person (\$16 per day).

Single Room: \$1,780 additional.

Registration: A deposit of \$500 per person is required at the time of registration. Final payments are due ninety (90) days prior to departure (March 22).

TOUR CONDITIONS

Included in Your Tour Price

Price: Prices quoted are per person and in US dollars and are based on fares and costs in effect at the time of publication. Whenever possible, DC&T obtains price guarantees from suppliers. However, depending upon the strength of the US dollar and the fluctuating nature of oil, gas and other costs, published rates are subject to change without notice. **Credit Cards** may be used for the **deposit** only. If final payment is made by credit card, there will be a convenience fee of **\$125** added per person.

Air Transportation: Group travel via jet economy class on El Al Airlines. Tickets must be completed 45 days prior to departure. Tickets cannot be changed once issued. **Note:** Passengers may arrange their own air & pay the ground price. Passengers doing their own air **MUST** meet the group at the airport or hotel.

Deviations/Stopovers: An individual change in the return date that is a deviation from the basic group itinerary will **NOT** be allowed.

Hotels: Four & five star hotels throughout. Prices are based on two persons sharing a twin-bedded room with private bath. **Single rooms** are subject to availability for an additional cost of **\$1,780. If a passenger cannot supply a roommate and Discovery Cruises and Tours is unable to do so, or your roommate cancels before departure, the passenger will have to pay the supplemental charge.** (You may be billed after the final payment date for single room accommodations as necessary.)

Meals: Three meals daily: breakfast, lunch and full dinners upon arrival in Israel. No lunch on free day.

Sightseeing: Local transportation is by deluxe, air-conditioned motor coach. The services of an English-speaking guide and entrance fees to places visited are included in tour price.

Airport Taxes/Surcharges: Included in the cost of the tour is \$760 for airport taxes and fuel surcharges

(actual cost as of 8/10/2023 **Note:** (Taxes and fuel surcharges may change without notice. Any increase will be billed to the passenger and must be paid prior to departure.)

Not Included in the Tour Price

Passport costs; beverages not usually included with regular meals; optional tours and excursions not mentioned in this itinerary; accident and baggage insurance; and transporting and handling excess luggage. **Tips of \$192 will be included on final invoice.** In the event it becomes necessary to overnight material due to late receipt of registration or final payments, traveler will be billed for these charges.

For Your Protection

Insurance: Acting only as agents for suppliers, Discovery Cruises and Tours is not responsible for damage, loss, or theft of luggage and/or personal belongings, or for personal injury, accident and/or illness. For your own protection, it is important that you have adequate insurance to cover these possibilities. You should carry proof of insurance in the event you need medical attention while in Israel. Upon receipt of your statement, via an email, the link for optional insurance will be provided.

Important Information Please Read Carefully

Passport: A valid passport is required and must be obtained in person by each tour member. No visas are required for Israel. A valid passport is required to leave the USA. **It should be valid for a minimum of SIX MONTHS after your return date;** you will be denied boarding if your passport is not valid for SIX MONTHS beyond your return date (December 22, 2024).

Registration & Deposit: A deposit of \$500 per person is required at the time of registration. The deposit may be charged to your Visa, MasterCard or American Express. Registrations received inside ninety (90) days (after March 22) must be accompanied by full

payment, and a \$30 LATE REGISTRATION FEE will be assessed.

Payments: After you have registered for the tour, you will receive an invoice with final payment amount and date due. Final payments should be made payable to DISCOVERY CRUISES AND TOURS and must be received ninety (90) days prior to departure (March 22). Final payments received inside ninety (90) days will be assessed a \$30 LATE PAYMENT FEE. NOTE: ALL reservations not fully paid by the ninety-day deadline are subject to cancellation, for which the Tour Operator is not to be held responsible.

Airline Seats: Seats without a deposit must be released 100 days from departure. If you cancel your airline seat with DC&T in writing within the 100 days there is a penalty of \$100 per person.

Cancellations and Refunds

If a passenger cancels his/her tour membership for any reason up to 91 days prior to departure (March 23) there will be a cancellation fee of two hundred dollars (\$200) to cover administrative and communication costs. For cancellations from 90-75 days prior to departure there will be a cancellation fee of \$500. Cancellations received 74-59 days prior to departure: penalty is 25% of tour cost; 58-30 days: penalty is 50% of tour cost; NO REFUND for cancellations within 29 days of departure. ***Trip cancellation and interruption insurance is available and is highly recommended.*** All cancellation requests must be addressed to Discovery Cruises and Tours in writing. Phone calls for cancellations cannot be accepted.
